

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES HELD ON MAY 22,
2018 AT 6:00 P.M. AT THE VILLAGE HALL

The Mayor opened the meeting at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Tripodi began by informing the board that he has been in the area for years and has always tried to be a good neighbor. He proposes to purchase Pray to the Lord Foundation Properties – 349.17-7-6 and 349.17-7-7 – and then tear the buildings down. After demolition he would then deed 20 feet of property to the Village for a road into Riverside Park. This road would be a straight access from Division St. and would better accommodate emergency vehicles. The road situated in this area would then give Mr. Tripodi assurance as to the access of the park and allowing for the safety of his dog and kids. Tripodi says he has an agreement with Pray to the Lord as we meet. If the Village approves, he will purchase immediately and begin the process of demo.

The board thanked Mr. Tripodi and Ms. Altkin for coming and promised someone would be in touch.

Next, there was discussion on the tentative dog park. The Mayor informed our attorney that the dog park board had begun the process of a creation of a 501(c)3. Ms. Westfall suggested when completed we would create a dog park policy and the Mayor would assign a committee to oversee it. We would then have our attorney create a maintenance and use agreement with the dog park committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
