

2022-2023 BUDGET MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 23, 2021 AT 4:43 P.M.

PRESENT: Mayor Moore, Trustees Durning, Warner and Brown, CT Budine and DCT  
Bev Shirkey.

ABSENT: Dean Price

The Mayor opened the meeting. CT Budine informed the Board that Trustee Price wanted to remove the \$10,000 from the General Fund budget for demolition. He felt that since the EDRLF committee had committed to pay for demolition on a cases by case basis it would not be needed in next year's budget. Mayor Moore went on to state that he felt that the rules for serving on the EDRLF committee needed to be amended. He also felt that rules for loaning money should be adhered to.

Mayor Moore wanted to wait on making any decisions on the General Fund budget until he spoke with the Comptroller's office about funding for the water fund. He wanted clarification of what had to be paid for by the water fund. Mr. Moore was also working on getting numbers to fund a project to increase water pressure in parts of the Village. He felt that this should be put to the residents in a referendum.

It was decided to have another budget meeting after the Regular Session on December 14<sup>th</sup>.
