# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION AND FUNDING OF FRONT STREET STREET SCAPE (TEP) PROJECT

(Locally Administered Project)

Authorizing the implementation, and funding in the first instance 100% of the Federal-aid and State "Marchiselli" Program-aid eligible costs, of a transportation Federal-aid project, and appropriating funds therefore.

WHEREAS, a Project for the **Deposit: Front Street Streetscape** (Transportation Enhancement Program), P.I.N. 9009.33 (the Project") is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne by Federal funds, Local funds and In-Kind services for the Transportation Enhancement Program work; and Community Development Block Grant funds, Local Funds and In-Kind services for the Betterment work; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Deposit desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the Federal and non-federal share of the costs of the Preliminary Engineering/Design and Right-of-Way Incidentals work.

NOW, THEREFORE, the **Village of Deposit Board of Trustees**, duly convened does hereby

RESOLVE, that the **Village of Deposit Board of Trustees** hereby approves the above-subject project; and it is hereby further

RESOLVED, that the **Village of Deposit Board of Trustees** hereby authorizes the **Village of Deposit** to pay in the first instance 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the cost of the **Preliminary Engineering/Design and Right-of-Way Incidentals** work for the Project or portions thereof; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$158,000 (\$113,000 TEP: Preliminary Engineering/Design and ROW + \$45,000 Betterment: Preliminary Engineering/Design) is hereby appropriated from General Fund and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phases of the Project; and it is further

RESOLVED, that in the event the full #ederal and non-Federal share costs of the

project exceeds the amount appropriated above, the Village of Deposit Board of Trustees shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the New York State Department of Transportation thereof, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the **Mayor** of the **Village of Deposit** be and is hereby authorized to execute all necessary Agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid and/or Marchiselli Aid on behalf of the **Village of Deposit** with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of project costs and permanent funding of the local share of Federal-aid and State-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible, and it is further

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary Agreement in connection with the Project, and it is further

RESOLVED, this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
