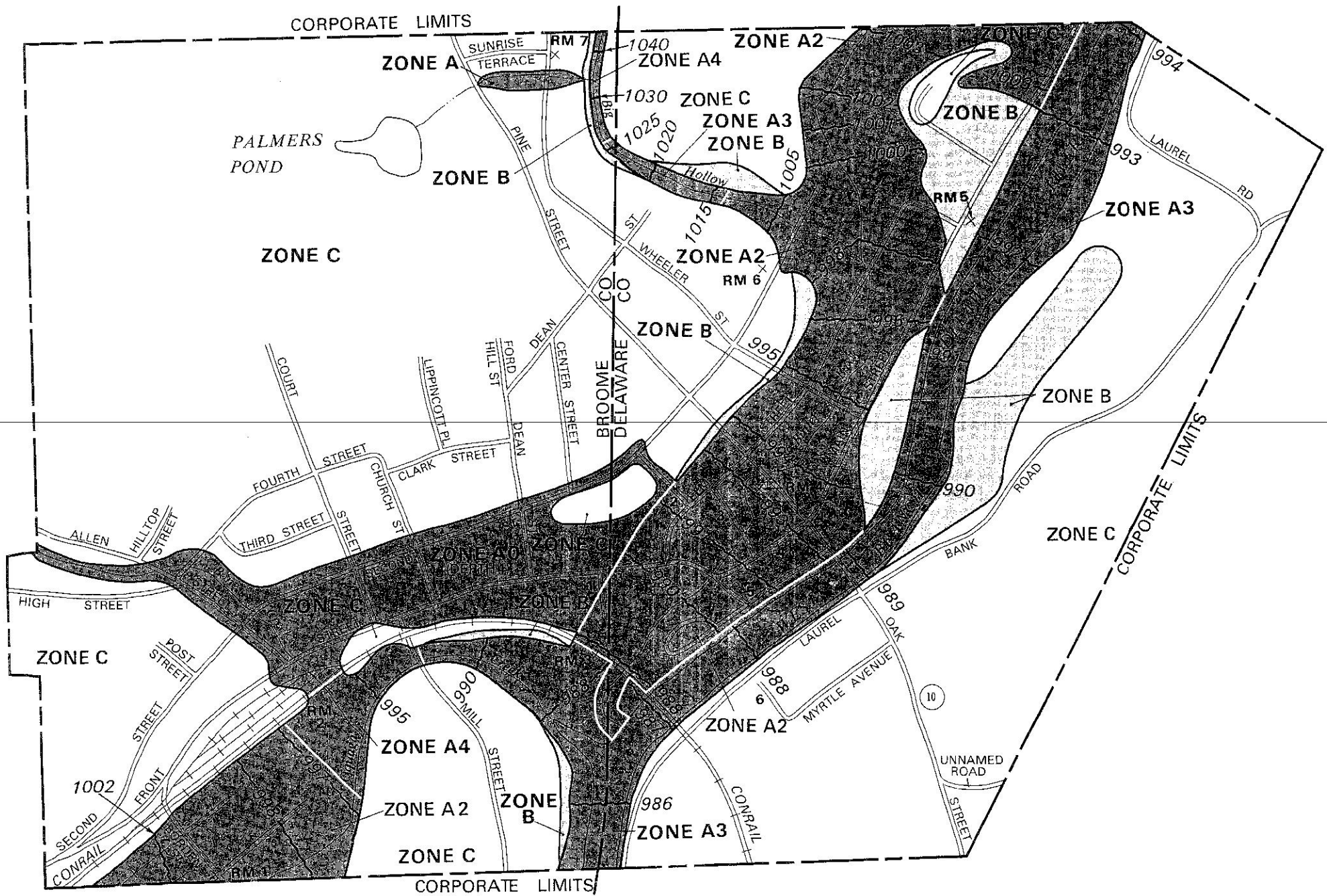

ELEVATION REFERENCE MARKS

REFERENCE MARK	ELEVATION (FT. NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM 1	1001.15	Nail in disc on power pole at the 90 degree turn in Borden Street.
RM 2	1002.93	USGS standard disc in headwall at southeast corner of railroad culvert on Bone Creek.
RM 3	997.01	USGS standard disc in the west end of the north bridge seat for the Conrail tracks over the West Branch Delaware River.
RM 4	991.79	Nail in disc on power pole by Pine Street Bridge over Butler Brook.
RM 5	1000.85	Nail in power pole on east side of Route 10, just north of the intersection of Boulevard Street.
RM 6	991.27	USGS standard disc set in concrete post at ground level in the southwest corner of the high school yard.
RM 7	1057.32	Nail in power pole on the east side of Wheeler Street at the intersection of Sunrise Terrace.

NOTES TO USER

Certain areas not in the special flood hazard areas (zones A and V) may be protected by flood control structures.

This map is for flood insurance purposes only; it does not necessarily show all areas subject to flooding in the community or all planimetric features outside special flood hazard areas.

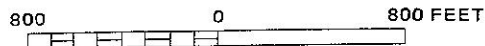

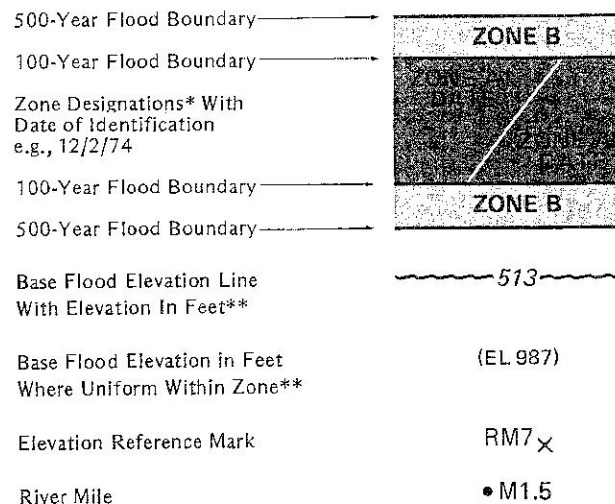

*EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS

ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
A0	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depths of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A30	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; or certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile; or areas protected by levees from the base flood. (Medium shading)
C	Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading)
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
V1-V30	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.
